1/25/2017	Alan Case	03 - Broadhead Flight Rules	Removed fletching length and height requirements. The requirements were very complex and inconsistent between divisions and class and didn't seem to add much value to the competition. Bottom Line: Would we rather spend our time checking and modifying fletching on our hunting legal arrows, or would we rather spend this time enjoying the broadhead shoot? Conventional & Compound Broadhead removed the following requirements: "The total combined length of the fletching shall not be less than 12 inches (30.5 cm) for men, and 10-1/2 inches (26.7 cm) for Women and Youth. Each feather or vane shall not be less than 7/16 inches (11 mm) in height." Longbow Broadhead removed the following requirements: "The total combined fletching shall not be less than 5 inch (12.7 cm) long feathers for Men and three 4-1/2 inches (11.4 cm) long feathers for Women and Youth. Each feather must not be less than 1/2 inch (13 mm) in height. Feathers must retain their parabolic or straight line shape. iii) Concave fletching shapes are not allowed. "Boat Tail" shapes are not allowed. A "Boat Tail" fletch is defined as any portion of the high point occurring in the forward half of the fletch." Primitive Broadhead removed the following requirements: "The total combined fletching shall not be less than three 4 inch (10.2 cm) long feathers or vanes for Women, Men, and Youth competitors. Each feather or vane shall not be less than 1/2 inch (13 mm) high."

	Alan Case	02 - Flight Equipment Rules - Primitive Simple Composite	Corrected the Primitive Simple Composite rule from "Bow is Constructed with a maximum of 2 wood or bamboo laminations." , to "Bow limb is constructed with a maximum of 2 natural material laminations. Examples include wood, bamboo, horn, bone, etc. Sinew, linen or silk cloth, rawhide, or any other type of "skin" backing will also count as a lamination."
